VIRTUAL VIDEO PRESENTATION GUIDELINES (RESEARCH PAPER)

- Dress formally.
- Make sure the room has enough light and prepare a plain white background.
- Make sure the room is quiet and eliminate any possible source of surrounding noise.
- The resolution of the video should be of high definition (720p or 1080p). Also, the video should be saved as MP4 or other common file format that can be opened on Windows or Mac.
- Prepare a computer with good internet connection, good speakers, and a microphone.
- The presenter may use any screencast video recording software such as OBS, screencast-o-matic, etc.
- The presenter should prepare a 10-minute video presentation where:
 - a. The presenter must present in front of a camera or;
 - b. Voice over the PowerPoint or;
 - c. A combination of any other creative methods of presentation
- Make sure your webcam recording does not cover the text of your slides.



• Start the presentation by introducing yourself, your supervisor (if any), and your research title.

- Suggestion for the content of slides:
 - a. Title slide
 - b. Background context
 - c. Method/approach/principles
 - d. Findings include data
 - e. Recommendations
 - f. Conclusion
- All information such as the title of your paper, authors' name, affiliation as well as your photo must appear on the first slide of your presentation.
- Presentation can be either in English or Malay.
- Leave your email address on the last slide for Q & A Session.
- Upload the video file on Google Drive/YouTube/any video online platform and share
 the (1) video link and (2) presentation slides to the organizer at
